On behalf of the entire Isle of Wight County Fair Committee, I would like to cordially invite you to the 30th annual County Fair, winner of International and Statewide awards. The Committee has planned another wonderful event this vear to honor and celebrate our great community. The theme for this year is "Come One, Come All—Isle of Wight's Got It All" to commemorate the Isle of Wight County Fair Committee's commitment to bring you the best Fair it can to honor its deep and strong agricultural heritage. We are looking forward to and hoping for this years' fair to be our very best!!!

We have two popular events for an early kick-off to the fair again this year. Our very exciting Truck and Tractor Points Pull the night of Saturday, September 9th and the wonderful, delicious Seafood Fest on Wednesday, September 13th featuring all you care to eat fried catfish, steamed shrimp, fried chicken, coleslaw, baked beans, hushpuppies and beverages, with entertainment by the regional band "Nashville Nights."

There are some new and exciting things at the fair this year in addition to a few of the great attractions we have had in past years. We are bringing the popular Southwest Dairy Farmers Mobile Dairy Classroom back this year, where they will be doing educational milking demonstrations over by the Field and Garden Building. Laser Tag is coming back and best of all, it is free to the patrons. Another returning and popular attraction we are having this year, is Axe Throwing, a great experience indeed. The Demolition Derby is back again on Sunday afternoon, bringing a bigger show than ever to our fair, including the kids Power Wheels competition! The ever-popular Hay Bale decorating contest, is back again, where round bales of hav are decorated by the schools, various businesses and a few by individuals. In addition, this year, fair attendees will be able to get admission tickets cheaper if bought online in lieu of at the gate!!! Please visit our website at thefairiscoming.com for more detail.

Again, this year, the fair is bringing back the excitement of "Bull Riding"

and "Barrel Racing" along with "Mutton Bustin" and "Mini Bull Riding" at the Rodeo arena with real cowboys!! In the Field and Garden building, our local farmers and gardeners can compete for best crops, and the little ones can play in a corn /soybean box. In partnership with the Isle of Wight Schools, there will be goats, rabbits, chickens and maybe even a heifer or two, where they are showcasing their Land Lab farming skills. Our local 4-H folks will feature a feeder pig, heifer show, goat show, and ham competitions in the 4-H building.

Be sure to visit our International Award Winning, Agriculture Education Center, a donated grain bin that houses flat screen tvs with various videos featuring planting, growing and harvesting a variety of farm crops and the raising of livestock including "birthing" of animals. If you watch closely, many of the videos feature some of our local area farmers. In that area is a farm life wall mural that the children will be able to color and fill in and various games. Outside, the kids milk a cow in our Farmer for a Day display, and play to their hearts content, in the huge sand box out in front of the center.

We have four ground acts planned again this year including a new and a little different "The Pompeyo Family & Their Amazing Dogs" as seen on America's Got Talent with many stunts and tricks with their rescue dogs!!! Another new show this year is "MAX Power and Nitro", a roaming show with a 9-foot tall and 5-foot-wide robot walks, talks and dances throughout the fairgrounds. New this year, is "Rock-N-Circus", a fast paced, high-energy show of juggling, aerial stunts magic and a 65-foot-high dive, amazing audiences everywhere. In addition, the "Firefighter Training Show" is back, a family oriented educational show and entertaining kid event., where kids will be invited to participate.

We have a fantastic entertainment lineup, with performances of several genres, on either the Duke Chevrolet GMC Stage or the Barton Ford Stage almost the entire time the fair is open. On Friday night, there will be Virginia's own Spencer Hatcher opening for National recording star, Brandon Lay with songs such as "Speakers, Bleachers and Preachers". On Saturday night will be regional band, Running Shine will be opening for country singer and songwriter Dillon Carmichael with chart topping songs, such as "Son of A", "Lucky Man", and "Dancing Away With My Heart". In addition, we have many popular regional and local bands entertaining on both stages, including Soul Patch, Zen Mojo, Strictly Bizzness and on Sunday during the car show, there will be Main Street Band!!

Deggeller Attractions will be here to provide a large variety of midway rides for all ages. We will have twenty-four food vendors (mostly local) to provide a huge variety of wonderful fair food, to satisfy almost any appetite. There will be Antique Tractors and equipment, Monster Truck Rides, the Car Show, Award-winning Face Painting and Camel and Pony Rides.

Thursday night is carload night where admission and ride tickets for up to eight legally seated in a car is \$50.00 if bought online in advance, a very good deal for families. Friday is school day with special group rates and Senior Day where Senior Citizens get in between 10 am and 2 pm for \$1.00. We also have special "Sunflower Hours" on Friday from 12 pm - 4 pm where our patrons with disabilities can get in for \$1.00. 

Agricultural Education

There will be many exhibits highlighting the work of the small farmer. You will see displays on bee hives, small barns, peanut stacks, pumpkin patches, portable chicken houses and fenced areas, row crops, farmers markets, and even lemonade stands. In addition, there will be several displays on gardening and horticulture put on by the Western Tidewater Master Gardeners and competitions for field crops, vegetable crops, and floral displays.

The Agriculture Education Center is a 1000 square foot grain bin that was generously donated by fair supporters in 2014 and is used to educate young people and adults about the importance of farming, crop growing, gardening and raising livestock. Six workstations offer games to play that provide a journey through owning and operating a farm, selling at a farmer's market, the importance of whole grains in our diet and understanding the mysteries of where our food comes from. The Agriculture Education Center is set up with handson activities and large screen monitors to see animal birthing demonstrations, planting and harvesting by local farmers. The grain bin is totally educational and fun for families.





Brandon Lay

Sometimes all it takes to move forward is remembering where you've been. And for Nashville artist Brandon Lay, that's where his next step lies.

Back with a new batch of vintageinspired country rock, the hard-totame son of a Tennessee preacher has reembraced the organic edge of his own sound – a potent style he knows by heart.

Born in Jackson, Tennessee, Lay's early life was a perfect illustration for his gutsy musical identity, raised right in the geographical middle of Memphis rock and Nashville country. Coming out of college, he combined that influence with a reputation for captivating crowds and guitar-slinging charisma, signing a major-label recording deal in 2017. But after a handful of early singles took him elsewhere, Lay's primed for an all-natural change.

"Every artist is different, but I'll

put it this way. I grew up playing all the honky tonks and biker bars, but that aggressive kind of sound didn't match what was on the radio," he explains, considering his new path. "That was a bridge that I felt like this project had to make. ... We wanted to match the live show with what people were hearing."

The shift arrives just in time for this gifted singer-songwriter - and in a way, it all feels meant to be.

Wearing his soul on his sleeve, Lay's disconnect between the studio and stage brought him dangerously close to disillusion. But with the forced recalibration of a global pandemic, and the move to a 50-acre spread on the outskirts of Nashville with his wife and two children, he pulled himself back from the brink. And with tracks like "Broke," he's trusting his instincts once again.

Co-written with Country Music Hall of Famer Dean Dillon ("The Chair," "Oceanfront Property"), "Broke" welds Lay's gravel-road vocal to a smooth-driving power ballad, comparing a relationship on the rocks to broken-down car – and imagining Lav as the mechanic who can fix it.

With a wide open country-rock sound and all the passion he was missing, it's an anthem custom built to take another shot at forever. And with it, Lay turns the ignition on a new chapter.

"It's the one song we cut where I almost feel like I'm singing a classic George Strait song," he says. "Comfortable is a great way to describe it. It will point my fans in the direction this whole project is going. ... It's got that throwback feel and it's harmony friendly, and I think it's got the elements that are gonna let people know what's on the way."


Carmichael followed it up in 2021

Firefighter Training Show

The Firefighter Training Show plays off every child's curiosity to one day be a "Firefighter - Hero."

The show allows volunteers from the audience, usually kids but we can use adults, to become our firefighter trainees(audience participation show). After being fitted in fire jacket and helmet the new trainees are introduced to the audience as their next generation of heroes and the volunteer firefighters are divided into two teams.

When the alarm tones sound calling engine one to duty it's all trainees on deck. Each firefighter trainee/team gets to complete the basic tasks at our simulated fire scene: laying out fire hose, attaching it to the fire truck and putting on a nozzle. Using a real fire extinguisher to squirt water at simulated flames in our smoke rescue building in hopes they can knock the flames out of the window putting out the fire.(To enhance the simulated fire effect we use an odorless, non-toxic, white smoke; smoke dissipates in about 1 to 3 minutes) The dialog between our fire chief the audience and the new trainees is riddled with humor and educational information such as, in case of fire "Get Outside and Stay Outside" only firefighters attempt rescues. In between fire alarms the fire chief also introduces important fire safety lessons "Don't Hide, Get Outside" and "Crawl Low, Under Smoke."



television show The Big Brunch and on top contestant on the Food Network's Kids Baking Championship, season 3, and owner of KC's Buttercream Sweet Shoppe.

Earn blue-ribbon bragging rights

You can't win blue-ribbon bragging rights if you don't enter the State Fair of Virginia competitions.

Blue-ribbon winner Novelle Wilkerson of Prince George County said people need to "get out of their comfort zones" and enter a competition. That's what she did.

Wilkerson had purchased a beginner crochet kit to take on a long-distance road trip. After she taught herself to crochet, she decided to enter a couple of crochet categories in the State Fair's creative arts competitions last year.

A mosaic crocheted afghan that took her 8 months to make won a blue ribbon and a "Best of Section" award.

Over 3,500 Virginians entered the State Fair's creative arts, culinary and horticulture competitions last year, and their entries were displayed during the fair. Some categories offer winners small cash prizes in addition to bragging-right ribbons. But it's the blue ribbons that many competitors care about the most.

The fair's competitions have categories for bold bakers, green growers, knowledgeable knitters, weaving wizzes and more. And there are categories for both adults and youth.

Competition guides with entry deadlines, registration and category descriptions for culinary and creative arts and horticulture entries are online at StateFairVa. org. The 2023 State Fair of Virginia will be held from Sept. 22 through Oct. 1.

New this year are grilled cheese and charcuterie competitions. "Grilled Cheese Your Way" will be held on Sunday, Sept. 24, at 1 p.m. Competitors will be invited to bring ingredients for their signature grilled cheese, which they will prepare in front of a live audience using skillets and burners provided by the fair.

Those interested in competing in the Charcuterie Competition will need to assemble their boards using at least four Virginia products, and then bring the charcuterie platters to the fair for judging.

The fair also is offering new Virginia outdoor-themed categories, including deer and fish mounts and antler art.

Returning favorites include a salsa competition and a scarecrow contest—both part of the horticulture category.

Longtime competitor and multiple-ribbon winner Lesley Russell from Henrico County said everyone has something they are good at, and she encourages other Virginians to try their hand at entering at least one of the competitions.

"They don't have to be crazy like me and bake for four days straight," Russell quipped. "But everyone should try."

Sarah Jane Thomsen, the fair's manager

of agriculture education and strategic programming partnerships, noted that anyone can enter the arts and crafts, culinary and horticulture competitions if they meet the criteria.

"Some people think you have to win at a county fair before you can compete at the state fair, but that's not the case," she said.

She added that in addition to winning ribbons and bragging rights, competitors in many classes contribute to the fair's mission of educating the public about agriculture and drawing connections to where fairgoers' food is grown.

The State Fair is held each fall at its permanent home at The Meadow Event Park in Caroline County. The event celebrates the best of Virginia's past, present and future through scholarship initiatives, creative programming and a focus on the commonwealth's agriculture and natural resources industries.


